MARKET COMMENTARY

The fund price grew by 1.2% in February. It has declined 1.8% since the beginning of the year. Panic selling triggered purchase opportunities during the reporting month. We also increased our positions in Apple, Berkshire Hathaway, Burberry, Grenkeleasing and Novo Nordisk. Starbucks and Phillips 66 were also added. In the bond segment, we purchased two subordinated bonds with Depfa and UniCredit, with each offering an expected yield of more than 10 percent. Grenkeleasing and Novo Nordisk did extremely well with excellent growth figures. Coca-Cola, LVMH, Munich RE and Takkt announced significant dividend increases. The fund allocation is comprised of 72% shares, 25% bonds and 3% liquidity. Our stock portfolio focuses on consumer goods, the outlook for which is additionally stimulated by low interest rates and oil prices. At the same time, we continue to hold a series of money market substitute bonds, which provide stability and flexibility to the fund.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND - PHILOSOPHY

In the selection of the fund's positions the philosophy of value investing is combined with an "event-driven value" approach. The aim is to reduce fundamental risks in the selection of the fund's positions by focusing on companies with strong business quality. By business quality the management means business models that stand out for their sustainability, the ability to defend an existing competitive advantage and the capacity to generate high free cash flows. The portfolio is diversified through various types of event and different holding periods. Interest paper and bonds can be added to the portfolio.

PERFORMANCE VS. INDEX MSCI WORLD (50%), EONIA TR (50%)


